The Kenya domiciled in the Ministry of Environment and Forestry, is charged with the mandate of providing timely and accurate early warning weather and climate information for safety of life, protection of property and conservation of the environment for sustainable development. To fulfil its mandate, the Department undertakes weather and climate observations, data exchange, data processing, analysis and forecasting as well as dissemination of weather information and products.

The Department's responsibilities include:

- Operation of a network of meteorological stations for the collection of data required for application purposes;
- Issuance of weather forecasts, advisories & alerts and dissemination of these products to the general public;
- Provision of meteorological services, weather forecasts and warnings and other information for the needs of civil and military aviation;
- Publication of reports of weather and climate and supply of meteorological information and services for the needs of Kenyan communities and in particular for the application in agriculture, transport, water resources management, construction, tourism and industry, and energy; and
- Issuance of weather forecasts for marine activities over the western Indian Ocean and inland water bodies.

The Ministry of Environment and Forestry has developed two vital documents to guide the delivery of meteorological services in Kenya. These are;

1. Kenya Meteorology Policy; and
2. National Meteorology Bill 2020.

Pursuant to the requirements of the Public Participation Act 2018 and the Constitution, the Ministry invites the public to the virtual National Validation Workshop to be held on 15th December 2020 to review the revised Meteorology Policy and Bill Documents.
